Arrangements during Inclement Weather

As a general rule, Preliminary interview will be held as scheduled when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or lower, or/ and “Amber”/ “Red” Rainstorm Warning Signal is/ are in force. Preliminary Interview will be cancelled when Tropical Cyclone Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement / Tropical Warning Signal No. 8 or above, “Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is in force. Details of the arrangements under inclement weather conditions are tabulated below:

1.	Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal and “Extreme Conditions” Announcement	
	Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or below is in force.	Preliminary Interview will be conducted as scheduled.
	Tropical Cyclone Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement / Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is issued / is in force within the 3 hours’ period immediately before the scheduled reporting time.	Preliminary Interview will be cancelled.
	Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is cancelled 3 hours before the scheduled reporting time.	Preliminary Interview will be conducted as scheduled.
2.	Rainstorm Warning Signal	
	“Amber” or “Red” Rainstorm Warning is in force.	Preliminary Interview will be conducted as scheduled.
	“Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued / in force within the 3 hours’ period immediately before the scheduled reporting time.	Preliminary Interview will be cancelled.
	“Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled 3 hours before the scheduled reporting time.	Preliminary Interview will be conducted as scheduled.

Note: In the event of cancellation of interview sessions due to the inclement weather conditions as stated above, rescheduling of the interview will be arranged for the affected candidates.
