Interview arrangements under inclement weather conditions

As a general rule, interviews will be held as scheduled when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or lower, or/ and “Amber”/ “Red” Rainstorm Warning Signal is/ are in force. Interviews will be cancelled when Tropical Cyclone Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement / Tropical Warning Signal No. 8 or above, “Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is in force. Details of the interview arrangements under inclement weather conditions are tabulated below:

i.	Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal / “Extreme Conditions” Announcement Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or below is in force. Tropical Cyclone Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement / Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is issued / in force within the 3 hours’ period immediately before the scheduled interview time. Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or “Extreme Conditions” Announcement is cancelled 3 hours before the scheduled interview time.	 Interview will be conducted as scheduled. ii.	Rainstorm Warning Signal “Amber” or “Red” Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force. “Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued / in force within the 3 hours’ period immediately before the scheduled interview time. “Black” Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled 3 hours before the scheduled interview time. In the event of cancellation of interviews due to the inclement weather conditions as stated above, rescheduling of the interviews will be arranged for the affected candidates.
